



Dear Public Housing Family,

As you are all aware, the Corona Virus (COVID-19) is spreading rapidly within in the United States. The Housing Authority of the City of Winston-Salem is committed to the safety of all public housing families and staff. The US Department of Housing and Urban Development has issued a series of waivers to existing regulations, allowing the Housing Authority to revise certain practices that may put the health and well-being of staff and residents at risk. Temporarily, the Housing Authority will be altering several rules and provisions relating to its management of its Public Housing Program. The specific waivers, and the alternative requirements that they represent, are outlined in the attached Waiver Chart. For further information on each waiver, please review Public & Indian Housing Notice 2020-13(HA), REV-1 issued on July 2, 2020. While we recognize these temporary changes may be confusing, but the purpose is to relieve you and the Authority of additional administrative burdens at this time.
